THE PROJECT

CIRC4INC – Learning Circle for Inclusion through Digital Tools is a 16-month project co-funded by the Italian National Agency under the Erasmus+programme. The project brings together three partner organisations: Università delle LiberEtà (Italy), as the coordinator; We Learn (Ireland); and Itinéraires (France).

The project's objective is to establish learning circles focused on promoting social inclusion for people aged 65 and older and/or those with limited digital skills. The project aims to promote the mindful use of the Internet and social media, aiming to extend these inclusive practices across partner and stakeholder networks.

ANALYSIS AND REPORT ON LEARNING CIRCLES

The project's first activity has focused on identifying the challenges faced by people over 65 and those with limited digital skills in using the Internet and social media mindfully, as well as the barriers they encounter when participating in traditional training courses. To explore these issues, a questionnaire was developed and distributed to 15 representatives of the target group across the three participating countries. In addition, the project partners conducted desk research to identify good practices relevant to the project's goals.

The findings have been compiled in a report, which is available on the <u>project's website</u>.
