### THE END OF THE PROJECT

CIRC4INC – Learning Circle for Inclusion through Digital Tools is a 16-month project co-funded by the Italian National Agency under the Erasmus+ programme. The project aimed to promote the mindful use of the Internet and social media using learning circles methodology for people aged 65 and older and/or those with limited digital skills to promote social inclusion.

It lasted 16 months during which, project partners have implemented the following activities:

- Creation of a report and analysis on learning circle methodology
- Creation of a guideline on learning circles
- Implementation of local workshops
- Creation of a guidebook
